COVID SECURE

NO EARLIER THAN 12 APRIL 2021

Weddings and civil partnership ceremonies are permitted for up to 15 people in COVID-19 Secure venues that are permitted to open. Ceremonies with up to 15 people can take place indoors in a Covid-19 secure venue.

Receptions can take place with up to 15 people in the form of a sit down meal and in any COVID-19 Secure outdoor venue that is permitted to open. Anyone working is not included in the limit for ceremonies or receptions.

NO EARLIER THAN 17 MAY 2021

Weddings and civil partnership ceremonies are permitted for up to 30 people in COVID-19 Secure venues that are permitted to open.

Receptions can also proceed with up to 30 people in a COVID Secure indoor venue, or outdoors. Anyone working is not included in the limit for ceremonies or receptions

Further details on receptions at this Step will be updated in due course..

NO EARLIER THAN 21 JUNE 2021

The Government aims to remove all restrictions and limits on weddings, civil partnership ceremonies and receptions subject to the outcome of the steps taken above.

SAFE WEDDINGS

DISPLAYING SYMPTOMS

Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19 will not be permitted to attend we strongly advise they follow advice on the NHS website.

TRAVELLING

You are allowed to travel in England to attend a marriage or civil partnership ceremony.

TEST AND TRACING

Contact information of all guests, visitors and suppliers attending the venue will be recorded to assist the NHS in tracking and tracing.

CLEANLINESS

All areas are cleaned thoroughly and sanitised before and after every event.

SANITISER STATIONS

Sanitiser Stations will be situated around the building for frequent use by staff and guests.

REMAIN SEATED AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

Socially distanced seating and spacing out of tables and chairs in line with the 1 metre plus guideline. Guests will be reminded to avoid physical contact with other households.

FACE COVERINGS

Face Coverings must be worn by all who are present. The only time you can remove your face covering is if you are seated to eat and drink.

VENTILATION

Doors and Windows must be open during the event to allow ventilation.

FACILITIES

Toilets will be regularly checked and cleaned throughout the day.

SHARING ITEMS

Objects such as Guestbooks, Polaroid cameras etc should be minimised with hand sanitiser available to be used before and after use.

TABLE SERVICE

Food and drinks will be served to your table.

TOUCH POINTS

Frequent touch points, such as door handles, will be regularly cleaned in the breaks.

ENTERTAINMENT

Music or background noise should be limited to avoid making conversations difficult. Dancing is not be permitted throughout the event. Any live music or performing arts are encouraged to perform outside. Where this is not possible, live music acts are to follow social distancing guidelines.

SINGING, CHANTING, INSTRUMENTS

Guests should avoid singing, raising voices and playing instruments at a volume that make conversations difficult. Instruments that are blown into should be avoided at this time.

HAND WASHING Guests, children and staff will be reminded frequently to wash their hands.

EXCHANGING RINGS

Wedding rings should be handled by as few people as possible and hands should be washed before and after.

INFANTS

Where an infant is involved in the proceedings, a parent/guardian or member of the infant's household should accommodate the infant and ensure they are frequently washing their hands for 20 seconds.
