COVID SECURE

CHRISTMAS BUBBLES

You can form an exclusive Christmas
Bubble composed of no more than three
households in a private setting, You can
not meet or socialise with your Christmas
Bubble in a hospitality setting. You can
only be in one Christmas Bubble and you
cannot change your Christmas Bubble at
any time.

TIER 2 SOCIALISING

You must not socialise with anyone you do not live with or who is not in your support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place.

STAYING OVERNIGHT IN HOTELS

You can stay overnight in a hotel during the Christmas period by yourself or with members of your household.

TABLE SIZES IN OUR RESTAURANT

We can take bookings of six people or less from the same household. You cannot mix with anyone who is not in your household or support bubble indoors.

TRAVELLING DURING CHRISTMAS

Between 23 and 27 December, you may travel between tiers and other nations of the UK if necessary to meet with other households in your Christmas bubble or return home. Once at your destination, you should follow the rules in that tier.



SAFE FESTIVITIES | OUR SAFETY MEASURES

DISPLAYING SYMPTOMS

Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19 will not be permitted to attend we strongly advise they follow advice on the NHS website.

TEST AND TRACING

Contact information of all guests attending will be recorded to assist the NHS in testing and tracing.

FACE COVERINGS

Face coverings are compulsory unless you are seated at a table to eat or drink. You must wear a face covering as soon as you leave your table.

CLEANLINESS

All areas are cleaned thoroughly and sanitised before and after every event. Facilities will be regurlarly checked and cleaned throughout the day.

SANITISER STATIONS

Sanitiser Stations will be situated around the building for frequent use by staff and guests.

REMAIN SEATED AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

Socially distanced seating and spacing out of tables and chairs in line with the 1 metre plus guideline.

TOUCH POINTS

Frequent touch points, such as door handles, will be regularly cleaned in accordance with our Covid safety policy.

TABLE SERVICE

Food and drinks will be served to your table.

HAND WASHING

Guests, children and staff are reminded frequently to wash their hands.

ENTERTAINMENT

Music or background noise will be limited to avoid making conversations difficult.

LAST ORDERS

Alcohol can only be served with a substantial meal. Last orders must be taken at 10pm for closure at 11pm.
